The Design Review Commission was unable to approve the full sign package at its September 21 special-called meeting because the wall signs are 8 square feet larger than ordinance allows.

Mayor McDonald said the Board needs to address signage on corner lots within the City's sign ordinances.

Alderman Parsons asked if the administration is considering this property a corner lot. Mayor McDonald explained that because this lot is adjacent to a private drive, it has the same attributes as a corner lot.

Alderman Elliott, the Board's liaison to the Design Review Commission, said she appreciated Krispy Kreme Donuts and City staff working toward a compromise. She polled the Commission members and a majority was in favor of this proposal.

Mayor McDonald explained that the urgency in getting this sign package approved is because Krispy Kreme plans to close on the property by September 30 and needed to know whether it would get its signs beforehand.

Bid for citywide pest control services.

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for Pest Control Services was advertised in *The Daily News* on July 31, 2015. Emails were sent to 12 prospective providers, along with an additional six by mail, including the current service provider. A mandatory pre-bid conference was held on August 14, 2015. Nine vendors attended the pre-bid meeting where the RFP was explained in depth, and the pricing sheet was given to each vendor for each location.

Six proposals were received. A scoring matrix was used to evaluate the proposals. The composite scores are listed in the table below. The overall high score was Nu Era Pest Control with an average score of 73.33, and a yearly cost of \$13,860.00. Nu Era demonstrated knowledge of pest control services by completing most of the requirements in the RFP and has excellent references. Also, Nu Era has a lower cost per treatment for ants, spiders and termites.

We recommend awarding the Pest Control Services to Nu Era effective upon execution of contract through June 30, 2016 with options to renew for two (2) one-term terms beginning July 1, 2016.

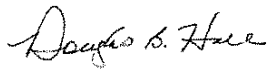

We appreciate this opportunity to provide professional engineering design and construction related services to the City for the proposed 500,000 gallon elevated water tank anticipated to be located within Nesbit Park. As we discussed previously, the City desires Fisher & Arnold, Inc. to develop necessary Contract Documents, Technical Specifications and Drawings to detail the requirements for the construction of this tank. Two options will be detailed for bid purposes; a composite tank utilizing a concrete base stem with steel tank and an all steel stem and tank. These two tanks will be bid simultaneously as a BASE BID and ALTERNATE BID. Alternative costs for each of these two types of tanks will also be obtained for a 750,000 gallon capacity. Additionally, the City desires Fisher & Arnold to provide all necessary geotechnical services required for the bid package along with construction administration and limited construction observation services after the Contract's award.

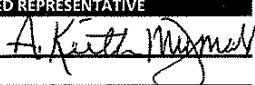

NEW BUSINESS **FINAL PLAN**

1. Bartlett Logistics Planned Development, 8370, 8380, 8390, 8400, 8410 and 8420 Wolf Lake Drive (Brenda Solomito, Solomito Land Planning)

INTRODUCTION: Ms. Brenda Solomito with Solomito Land Planning is requesting Planning Commission approval of a Final Plan for the Bartlett Logistics Planned Development (P.D.). The subject property is located at 8370, 8380, 8390, 8400, 8410 and 8420 Wolf Lake Drive within the "I-P" Planned Industrial Park Zoning District.

BACKGROUND: On July 6, 2015, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the Bartlett Logistics Planned Development (PD) to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BMA). On August 11, 2015, the BMA granted approval of the PD. The subject property was originally part of the Bartlett Logistics Center Phase 2 subdivision, approved by the Planning Commission on February 5, 2001.

DISCUSSION: The specific request by the applicant is for the approval of the Final Plan for the Bartlett Logistics PD. The approved PD consists of three (3) re-subdivided lots into six (6) lots each with an existing building. The lot sizes range from 1.9-acres to 3.3-acres in size. The existing 22-foot wide driveways will remain, and provide cross access to each of the six (6) lots. Addressing and main access to all of the lots will remain from Wolf Lake Drive.
