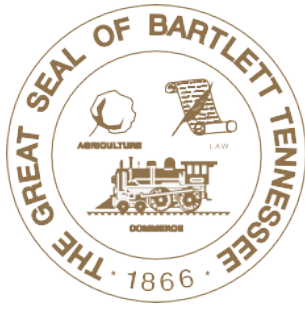

Bid to equip nine new police vehicles with emergency equipment. This equipment includes emergency lighting, sirens, rear prisoner seats, gunlocks, storage boxes, camera equipment, and computer equipment. Each of these items is a standard piece of equipment installed in all patrol vehicles and is required for use by officers during their duties.

OPEN DISCUSSION
